Our Senior Executive Team

T. Murray Wilson Executive Chairman

Murray Wilson has been Chairman of the Board since May 1, 2006, and Executive Chairman since August 14, 2006. During his 25-year investment banking career, Mr. Wilson has led numerous strategic and financing assignments for energy, mining, utilities and technology companies. He has also been a key advisor to a number of oil sands companies during their formative years. Prior to founding Stanway Capital in 2001, Mr. Wilson was the global head of oil and gas for TD Securities Inc. in Calgary and Vice Chairman of TD Securities International in London, U.K. Prior to that, he had a 17-year career with RBC Dominion Securities / Royal Bank of Canada, focused on mergers and acquisitions, equity and debt capital markets, and project finance in both Calgary and London. Prior to his investment banking career, Mr. Wilson was active on the technical side of the energy industry. He holds a Masters Degree in Business from the Sloan School, MIT, a Masters in Engineering from the University of Manitoba and a BSc in Chemical Engineering from Queen's University.

Christopher H. Hopkins, BSc, MBA President & Chief Executive Officer

Christopher Hopkins has served as President, Chief Executive Officer and a director since August 14, 2006, and President, Chief Executive Officer and a director of Oilsands Quest Sask Inc., a subsidiary of the Company, since November 10, 2004. From October 1999 to September 2004, Mr. Hopkins was a founder and the Executive Vice

President of Synenco Energy Inc. Mr. Hopkins was also a director of Synenco from October 1999 to August 2003. He was directly responsible for Synenco's exploration operations resulting in the identification of over two billion barrels of bitumen. Mr. Hopkins' 30 years of Canadian and international energy and mining experience includes executive positions in corporate planning and business development with Suncor's Oil Sands Group, Pembina Corporation and Amoco Canada. He also has specialized management experience in environmental control and regulatory affairs in the resource industry. He received an MBA in 1980 from Queen's University.

Karim Hirji, BComm, CA Chief Financial Officer

Karim Hirji has been Chief Financial Officer of the Company since August 14, 2006, and Chief Financial Officer of Oilsands Quest Sask Inc., since November 10, 2004. From November 2001 to June 2004, Mr. Hirji was the Vice President, Finance and Chief Financial Officer of Synenco Energy Inc. Prior to joining Synenco, he was Vice President, Finance and Chief Financial Officer of Anadime Corporation, a public oilfield services company, and, before that, Manager of Financial Reporting at Enbridge Inc. His background also includes five years with AGRA Inc., a major, public Canadian engineering company, in senior financial positions including Corporate Controller. He has significant treasury, project management and corporate finance skills. Mr. Hirji received his BComm from the University of Calgary and CA while articling with Deloitte & Touche LLP.

Erdal Yildirim, D Eng Sc Executive Vice President, Project Development

Erdal Yildirim has been Executive Vice President, Project Development since October 2, 2006. In 2008, he was appointed President of Oilsands Quest Technology Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary. From 1999 to December 2005, he was Senior Vice President, Engineering and Technology of Synenco Energy Inc. Dr. Yildirim received his Doctor of Engineering Science degree from the School of Engineering & Applied Science of Columbia University in New York City. He joined Cities Service Company in 1972 and was assigned to the Syncrude Project in 1974. Since then, he has been associated with numerous industry-leading oil sands projects. He was also a founder and Chairman of the Alberta Chamber Resources Oil Sands Task Force and the National Task Force on Oil Sands Strategies. Dr. Yildirim is General Manager of Canadian Oil Sands Network for Research Development (CONRAD), a non-profit organization dedicated to fostering collaborative research and development within the oil sands industry. He holds more than a dozen patents on oil sands technologies.

Errin Kimball Vice President, Exploration

Errin Kimball has been Vice President, Exploration of the Company since August 14, 2006, and Vice President, Exploration of Oilsands Quest Sask Inc. since July 2005. From January 2002 until June 2005, he was Chief Geologist at Synenco; he was also a geological consultant to Synenco from when it was formed in 1999 until he

assumed his staff position in 2002. His career has been balanced with successful exploration for various mineral exploration companies along with the stewardship of working with the Alberta Geological Survey (Alberta Energy and Utilities Board) as an Aggregate and Industrial Minerals Geologist.

Claes T.S. Palmgren, P. Eng.
Vice President, Reservoir Engineering

Prior to joining Oilsands Quest Inc. in February 2008, Claes Palmgren was Manager, Reservoir Process Technology at StatoilHydro Canada Ltd. (formerly North American Oil Sands Corporation) which he joined in 2006. At StatoilHydro Canada, Dr. Palmgren was responsible for reservoir process technology. From 2000 to 2006, Dr. Palmgren was with Petro-Canada, where he had key roles in Gas Over Bitumen hearings, the commercialization and start-up of the Mackay River SAGD project and Southern Gas Foothills Development and Exploration. From 2005 onward, he led the Joint Venture VAPEX Pilot operated by Petro-Canada at its Dover site. His background also includes reservoir engineering positions at CS Resources (later PanCanadian Resources) working the SAGD Pilot in Senlac, Saskatchewan and developing a field pilot program of a thermal solvent in-situ bitumen recovery process. His career in applied research, technology pilot program development and field applications of in-situ heavy oil and bitumen recovery technologies spans more than 20 years.

Paul K. O'Donoghue, MBA
Vice President, Investor Relations & Corporate Planning

Prior to joining Oilsands Quest Inc. in March 2008, Paul O'Donoghue was Vice President, Corporate & Strategic Development (and Corporate Secretary) of Trident Resources Corp. and Trident Exploration Corp., where he was a key member of senior management from Trident's inception in 2001. At Trident, Mr. O'Donoghue led a team that had overall responsibility for all corporate development matters, including

financings, acquisitions/divestitures, investor relations, risk management, marketing and legal affairs. During his time at Trident, production grew from zero at start-up to over 16,000 barrels of oil equivalent per day.

Prior to joining Trident, Mr. O'Donoghue held progressively senior positions in oil, gas and power businesses in Canada with Alberta Energy Company, Natural Gas Clearinghouse and PrimeWest Energy. At these firms, he concentrated on corporate finance, risk management and marketing.

Mr. O'Donoghue holds an MBA in Finance from the Rotman School of Business, University of Toronto (1990), and a BSc in Economics from Oklahoma City University (1984). He lives in Calgary, Alberta.
